SLOW FOOD BIBLE STUDIES: EPHESIANS 1:1-4:16 (34 studies); 4:17-6:24 (34 studies)

Did Paul write Ephesians, and if so, where was he and whom was he addressing? It has to be said that the evidence is inconclusive on all three questions. The traditional view is that it was indeed written by the apostle Paul from his house arrest situation in Rome around AD 61-2; and that it was sent to a church or churches in the Ephesus region of Asia Minor, at roughly the same time as Colossians and Philemon. Opponents of this view (basing their arguments on style, theological content and lack of personal references) have tried to produce alternative hypotheses, but these raise more problems than they solve. Perhaps Ephesians reads more like a homily, or an essay, than a letter, because it was a circular to a group of churches – it may even have been 'the letter from Laodicea' (Col 4:16). If it wasn't by Paul, then it was by someone else equally inspired, because by any standards it is an amazing piece of work.

The standard commentary on Ephesians is John Stott *The Message of Ephesians* (IVP BST 1979). H C G Moule *Studies in Ephesians* (1893, reprinted Kregel 1977) is full of good things despite its age. Tom Wright *Paul for Everyone: the Prison Letters* (SPCK 2nd ed 2004) is a favourite of many. Watchman Nee *Sit Walk Stand* (Victory Press 4th ed 1964) isn't a commentary but has much to offer devotionally. Some might also wish to dip into Ben Witherington III *The Letters to Philemon, the Colossians and the Ephesians* (Eerdman's 2007) which calls itself 'a socio-rhetorical commentary on the captivity epistles' and offers an interesting defence of Pauline authorship based on the stylistic expectations of the target audience.

1:1-4:16

1:19b-21 Do I have to feel strong as I face today? Ps 18:1-2, 29-35; 2 Cor 12:9-10; 1 In 4:4.

1:22-23 Do I tend to rubbish the church? *Dt* 4:20; *Song* 6:10; *Heb* 2:11; 1 *Pet* 2:4-10.

2:1-3 Why does Paul describe all of us as 'dead'? Surely that doesn't apply to me! Gen 6:5-6; Lk 15:24; Col 3:5-7.

2:4-7 How has God transformed this hopeless situation? *Isa* 53:10-12; *Rom* 6:3-4; *Tit* 3:3-7.

3:1-2 If I am experiencing difficulties in my present situation, what can I learn from Paul's attitude? *Jn* 12:24-26; 2 *Cor* 4:7-15.

3:3-6 Do I have to have special prophetic insight to understand God's will? Num 11:29; Jer 31:33- 34; Acts 2:17-18.

3:7-8 Am I proud of the way God has used me to speak to others (if he has)? 1 Cor 15:9-11; 1 Tim 1:12-16; 2 Pet 2:16.

3:9-10 When God's word is proclaimed in church, chapel or assembly, what is happening in the spiritual realm? *Isa* 55:10-11; 2 *Cor* 4:5-6; 1*Pet* 1:12.

3:11-13 Does God want idiots like me bothering him night and day? *Isa* 45:18-25; 2 Cor 3:4-5.

3:14-17a Is my relationship with Christ any more than a few minutes spent saying 'good morning'? Prov 8:34-35; Song 2:3b-4; Phil 3:10.

3:17b-19 How close does the Lord want me to get to him? *Isa* 57:15; *Mic* 6:6-8; *Jn* 15:5.

3:20-21 Is God reluctant to answer my prayers? *Mk* 11:22-25; *Jn* 14:13-14; *Rev* 8:3-5.

4:1-2 What Christlike qualities do I lack? Why? *Phil* 2:13; 2:20-21; 3:14; 4:1; 4:9.

4:3-6 Am I a unifying or divisive influence in the fellowship in which the Lord has placed me? 1 Chr 12:16-18; Jn 10:16; 1 Cor 12:12-13.

4:7-10 Am I thankful for the gifts Christ has given me? What has he given them to me for? *In* 20:22-23; 1 Pet 4:10-11; 2 Tim 2:24-26.

4:17-19 How can I reconcile what Paul says here about non-Christians with my experience of people in everyday life? *Isa* 53:6; *Jn* 16:3; *Rom* 1:21-22.

4:20-21 Do I consider myself to have graduated from the school of Christ? *Job* 36:22; *Ps* 119:102; *Phil* 3:12-16.

4:22-24 If I am a new person in Christ, how can I cooperate in the transformation process? 2 Cor 5:17; Col 3:9-10; 1 Jn 2:28-3:10. 'Put off... be made new ... put on' could be either a statement ('you have put off etc') or a command ('you are to put off') or both at the same time.

4:25 Am I living a lie? 1 Sam 16:7b; Ps 139:23-24; Jer 17:9; 1 Jn 1:6-7. This and the next six studies form a short course in practical self-examination. They can be combined; but it is recommended that they are taken one by one.

4:26-27 Have I lost my temper recently? *Lam 3:40; Prov 14:29; Jas 1:19-20.*

4:28 Am I in it for what I can get out of it? Ps 51:6; Prov 30:8-9; 2 Cor 9:6-7.

4:29 Should I have said that? *Prov* 15:4; 23; 16:24; 25:11.

4:30 Do I make it my aim to please the Lord? *Isa* 63:9-10; 1 Cor 6:17, 19; 2 Cor 5:9; 1 Jn 3:19-24.

4:31-32 Is there anyone (or anything) I can't forgive? *Gen* 50:15-21; *Lk* 23:34; *Acts* 15:36-39 with 2 Tim 4:11.
